OFFICER POSITIONS

◆ PRESIDENT: Shall call and conduct general meetings; shall create ad hoc committees as needed; shall represent the Society to the university, graduate school, Real Estate department administration, and to all non-university bodies; shall act as chairman of the executive committee; and shall appoint all parliamentarian.

♦ VICE PRESIDENT: Shall perform the function of the President during the incapacity of

the President or when delegated by the President to do so; shall serve as the liaison between the Society and the University Student Government; and shall serve on the executive committee.

SECRETARY: Shall take attendance and official notes at all Society and executive meetings; shall perform required customary secretarial duties; and shall serve on the executive committee.

TREASURER: Request funding from the University; shall keep all records of Society funds; shall authorize the dispersing and collecting of Society funds; shall prepare Societies budget with the cooperation of the other members; and shall serve on the executive committee.


